

# HOW WE ARE KEEPING OUR STUDENTS SAFE AT PLYMOUTH PRESCHOOL:



- Daily temperatures taking of all students, staff, and visitors.
- If someone is showing any symptoms of illness; including staff, they are being asked to not report to school/work.
- Specific staff assigned to sanitizing frequently touched areas- doorknobs, playground equipment, pens, restrooms, tabletops, etc.
- Toys, puzzles, and learning activity materials are being separated daily to sanitize.
- Maintaining small class ratios during the Covid19 pandemic- Maximum amount of people in a classroom, including the teacher is 10.
- Only staff and students are allowed in the classrooms. Tours are given when students are NOT present in the classroom. (We ask that parents to please abide by this policy.)
- Upon arrival and when a child is going home, hand washing/sanitizing is being re-enforced.

Please continue to help keep our school safe by:

1. Keeping your child at home, if he or she is ill.
2. Wearing a mask in the presence of non-household members, when away from school, and on the weekends.
3. Having your child wash their hands frequently at home.
